The proposal must include: 1) how the range will be used by individuals and state and federal law enforcement agencies for shooting and training purposes; 2) how the public can access the facility; 3) the scheduling of competitive shooting events; 4) the use of the range for shooting sport educational purposes; 5) staffing; and, 6) the amount of liability insurance coverage.
