\$3.00—Passenger Tire \$7.00—Large Truck Tire \$10.00—Heavy Equipment Tire

INERT WASTE

Fee—\$15/cu yd

Brick, concrete, clean soil or rock.

NO Large Loads over 2 cu yd. ONLY 2 loads of inert or brush daily.

WOODY WASTE

Brush, limbs, logs, pine needles, grass, garden waste accepted.

NO painted, treated, plywood, OSB, particleboard.

NO Large Loads over 2 cu yd. ONLY 2 loads of inert or brush daily.

ALL wood placed in a dumpster must be 4 foot or shorter in length.

REFRIGERANT UNITS

Fee-\$10

Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, water coolers, and anything containing Freon gas.

Note: Doors must be removed for safety reasons and the units must have shelves and contents removed.

Construction - Demolition - Remodeling Waste

Fee-\$20/cu yd

C&D Waste includes but not limited to:

Drywall, gypsum board, insulation, fiberglass, fireproofing material, veneer, vinyl, roofing materials, electrical and wiring materials, baling twine or wrap, painted/treated wood (fiberboard, particleboard, paperboard, plywood, pressboard, chipboard, pressure treated wood, wood composites), asphalt (paving & shingles), laminate, leather, linoleum, carpet & padding, construction tiles, porcelain bathroom fixtures, Styrofoam and textiles.

Burn barrels are not accepted. Hot ashes CANNOT be dumped into the dumpster or wood pile.

Cell Phone Policy

Please do not use your cell phone when entering container sites in Jefferson County.

The number one cause of injuries and fatalities of solid waste workers are from distracted drivers. Residents NOT complying with this rule may be asked to leave and make other arrangements for disposing of their trash.



BASIN

Accepts the following: Scrap metal, oil (5 gallons or less), antifreeze, paint, batteries, woody waste, with no brush limit.

BOULDER

Accepts the following:

Cardboard, paper, aluminum cans, scrap metal, antifreeze, oil (5 gallons or less), paint, batteries. Also woody waste and brush, with no load limits.

CLANCY

Accepts the following: Cardboard, scrap metal, antifreeze, oil (5 gallons or less), paint, batteries. Also woody waste and brush, with load limits.

JEFFERSON CITY

Accepts the following: Scrap metal, oil (5 gallons or less), antifreeze, paint, batteries.

MONTANA CITY

Accepts the following:

Cardboard, paper, aluminum cans, steel/tin cans, scrap metal, antifreeze, oil (5 gallons or less), paint, batteries, clean glass. Also woody waste and brush, with load limits.

WHITEHALL

Accepts the following:

Cardboard, paper, aluminum cans, steel/tin cans, scrap metal, antifreeze, oil (5 gallons or less), paint, batteries, clean glass. Also woody waste and brush, with no load limits.

Each site has an "up for grabs" area.
