**REQUIREMENTS OF THE DISTRICT COURT
FOR PERSONS OF THE AGE 16 OR 17 YEARS WHO WISH TO MARRY**

Montana Law, Section 40-1-213, MCA, 2021, provides that the District Court may order the Clerk of the District Court to issue a marriage license and a marriage certificate for any party age 16 or 17 years under the following conditions:

1. That the person 16 or 17 years of age have the consent of both parents or of the parent having actual care and custody of the minor.
2. The court must require both parties (irrespective of age) to participate in a period of marriage counseling involving at least two separate counseling sessions not less than 10 days apart with a designated counselor as a condition of the Order for issuance of a marriage license and marriage certificate form.
3. The marriage license and certificate form may only be issued if the Court finds that the underaged party is capable of assuming the responsibilities of marriage and the marriage will serve the best interest of the parties.
4. Pregnancy alone does not establish that the best interest of the parties will be served.
5. The parties wishing to marry must furnish the Court with a certificate from someone qualified as a marriage counselor in the following form:

The Court requires a letter from the marriage counselor indicating an opinion of the evaluator of the ability of the parties to assume the responsibilities of marriage and whether marriage is in the best interests of the parties.
