Private cable T V companies, oil & gas pipelines, communication companies, water system, and public and/or private irrigation systems crossing or using public right-of-way will be treated under the same schedule of fees as utility service installation and maintenance.

All costs incurred by the Jefferson County Road Department or its representatives associated with the testing, inspection, and correction of deficiencies will be charged to the responsible permittee.

Jefferson County reserves the right to require a performance bond securing the restoration of County facilities to assure compliance with right-of-way permit requirements.
